a) Update on SIM Mapping Workgroups

Two workgroups were developed as part of the SIM mapping workshop, they included one to look at housing needs and one to look at increasing MH/AODA providers.

- Housing group had one meeting. Looking to collect data on actual need in community from homeless, those coming out of corrections, diversion from psychiatric placement, etc. Will then explore grants and other opportunities for resource development.
- Providers group also had one meeting. Discussed expansion of services at DCMC looking to increase marketing of JAK's place and exploring development of more Peer Support services.

b) Update on Sober Housing

Currently no one in the house. Working with CORE regarding challenges we had in 25 and obstacles to admissions. Hoping to open these paths soon. Several potential participants would be eligible to utilize the sober housing.

c) TAD Grant Final Report

TAD Grant is due next week. All of 2026 is covered? 2026 grant has been confirmed with full funding allowing us to restart the program.

d) Treatment Court Program Review

Reviewed the program review documents from early visit in 2025. A few changes need to be made in the Policies and Procedures Manual. Currently working with HR for a job description changes. Hope to have the Counselor and Case Manager posting and recruitment starting soon.

e) Participant Admissions

Admissions remain on hold at this point. Hoping to start taking admissions again by June. Only two participants remain in the program.
