Rules Governing Exhibits

1. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed. Exhibitors will be required to furnish sufficient bedding during the Fair.
2. ALL GOATS MUST HAVE A SCRAPIES EAR TAG REGARDLESS OF SEX, AGE, or BREED.
3. Goats with full natural horns may not be entered unless full natural horns are a standard for a specific breed.
4. No Bucks may be entered.

Explanation of Individual Classes

(Age shall be determined as of the opening date of the Fair and the following age classifications shall apply.)

- Junior doe kid: under 4 months of age.
- Senior doe kid: at least 4 months but under 7 months of age.
- Junior yearling doe: at least 7 months but under 12 months of age.
- Senior yearling doe: at least 12 months but under 24 months of age and the doe is not in milk.
- ALL OF THE ABOVE ANIMALS SHALL HAVE NEVER FRESHENED
- Wether: Male, must be castrated, at least 6 weeks old
- Yearling milker: under 2 years of age and in milk.
- Junior milker: at least 2 years but under 3 years.
- Mature milker: at least 3 years but under 5 years.
- Aged milker: 5 years of age and older.

CLASS P - MARKET GOAT

Weight class divisions of light weight, medium weight, and heavy weight to be made by the Superintendent on Entry Day. The Fair has established that there will be no minimum or maximum weight to be able to show in market class. **Check Quality Market Animal Sale Rules regarding eligibility for sale.**

Premiums: \$5.00 \$4.00 \$3.00 \$2.00

CLASS Q - GOAT SHOWMANSHIP (Danish Judging)

Premiums: \$3.00 \$2.50 \$2.00 \$1.50

Age of member determined as of January 1 of exhibit year.

1. Senior, 15 years and over
2. Intermediate, 12-14 years
3. Junior, 8-11 years, who have previously shown goats
4. Beginners, 8-11 years, showing for the first time

CLASS R - CARCASS CONTEST

The carcass contest is under the direction of the Quality Market Animal Sale Committee. Entries must be exhibited at the Door County Fair and in the Door County Quality Market Animal Program (see QMAS Rules). Premiums will be awarded based on ultrasound judging results issued during weigh-in on opening day of the Fair. Additional prizes may be awarded by the Quality Market Animal Sale Committee to the Champion and Reserve Champion carcasses.

1. All entries (2 per exhibitor)
