### **CLASS DD - SINGLE FRYER**

1. Fryer not over 69 days or over 5 ½ pounds. (May not be entered in any other class.)

### **CLASS EE - MEAT PEN**

1. Meat pen consists of three rabbits. All rabbits shall be the same breed and variety. No rabbit may be over 69 days or over 5 ½ pounds. (May not be entered in any other class.)

### **CLASS FF - ROASTER RABBIT**

1. A single rabbit, either sex, between 70 and 180 days of age, weighing not less than 5 pounds (*but less than 8 ½ pounds is suggested*). (May not be entered in any other class.)

### **CLASS GG - PET RABBIT**

1. The exhibit consists of a single rabbit of either sex, over 6 months of age. Pet Rabbits will be the first judged on Show Day. Rabbits shown in Class GG may not be shown in any other class. Rabbits entered in Class GG - Pet Rabbit may be brought to the Fair on Show Day, judged, and then may be taken home if desired. They will not be required to stay on the fairgrounds.
