

## Frequently Asked Questions Regarding New Admission

\*Please note this is a working document meant to assist with clarifying the new admission process for the Door County Fair. As more questions come up this document will be updated.

### **Pricing:**

Daily Admittance: \$12

Season Pass - \$30

### **Pre-Fair Discount Rates:**

Daily Admittance: \$10

Season Pass - \$25

### **Age of Admission:**

4 and under are FREE

5 and up are priced as above

### **Volunteers/Workers/Exhibitors/Sponsors:**

Everyone falling under these categories will be receiving a paper pass that will need to be scanned upon entering the fairgrounds. Hand stamps will be needed if you plan to leave the grounds and return later on in the day.

### **Can I use cash to pay for my tickets?**

Cash may be used at the gates for the regular season prices.

### **I don't have a phone to show my ticket on. What should I do?**

QR tickets may be printed out and presented at the gates in paper form.

### **What if I don't know what day I'm planning to attend?**

None of the tickets are date specific, meaning if you purchase a daily pass, you can use it on any day of the 2025 fair.

### **Reduced Rates for Seniors:**

We genuinely appreciate and understand the concern for a senior discount. Although this has not been a tradition at the Door County Fair, we strive to keep our prices reasonable to ensure everyone can enjoy the variety of events and activities we offer.

**If someone purchases multiple tickets, do they have the ability to share with others? For example - if a parent purchases all of the tickets for the family, can they share it with their children who might come at a separate time from the parent?** Yes, you can share your QR code with your family. You may make as many paper copies or digital copies (screen shots, emails, text messages) as you want or need.

### **What if part of the family comes at one time and the rest come later?**

Answer with Daily pass – Let's say you are a family of 4 and you initially purchased 8 daily passes with a plan to go to the fair for 2 days. Mom and daughter arrive at the fair first. They can go through the gate and when the QR code is scanned only two daily passes will be used. When Dad and Son arrive later the same QR code is scanned using two different daily passes. This leaves 4 daily passes still to use at a later date.

Answer with Weekly pass – Again let's say you are a family of 4 and you initially purchased 4 Season Passes. Each day you arrive the QR code is valid for 4 scans (1 for each person). If you plan to come and go multiple times in one day you will need to pick up a wristband from the gate on your way out. The QR code will reset at Midnight and be valid for 4 more scans the next day.

**How many times can a season ticket be scanned? Is it every time they come to the gate? And if so - what is stopping someone from coming in and then sending the ticket to someone else to use that same day?** Each QR code is valid for one scan per ticket purchased. See examples below.

1 daily pass=1 available scan, available any day of the fair

4 daily passes = 4 available scans, available any day of the fair

10 daily passes = 10 available scans, available any day of the fair

1 Season Pass = 5 available scans/1 scan per day and will reset at midnight

4 Season Passes = 20 available scans/ 1 scan per ticket per day and all tickets reset at midnight

**\*\*\* If you are planning to leave the fair and return later you will need to get a hand stamp from the gate as you leave. Stamp shapes will change daily\*\*\***

## **DIRECTIONS FOR SCANNING FROM PHONE ARE BELOW**

### **How do I scan a QR Code on my phone?**

The easiest solution is to visit our website [www.doorcountyfair.com](http://www.doorcountyfair.com) and click on the QR Code at the top of the screen. No Scanning involved. However, see instructions below on how to scan from a phone.

#### **To Scan on iPhone:**

- 1 - Take a screenshot of the QR code**
- 2 - Open your photos app**
- 3 - Open the picture of the QR Code**
- 4 - Press and hold on the QR Code**
- 5 - A list of options should display - Click on "Open in Safari/Explorer)**

**You should be taken to the purchasing site**

#### **To Scan on Android**

- 1 - Take a screenshot of the QR code**
- 2 - Open the photos gallery**
- 3 - Press the yellow "T" button on bottom right of screen**
- 4 - Tap on QR code**
- 5 - Select "Open Link"**
