The Door County Parks Department and Land Use Services Departments are in the process of updating a Parks and Open Space Plan in compliance with Wisconsin DNR requirements. Having a Parks and Open Space plan enables municipalities to apply for both federal and state grant funding. An open house and Virtual open house meetings, described below, have been scheduled in order to present the draft plan and gather input.

- Chapter 3: Understanding the plan
- Chapter 4: Description of Planning Region, Proposed Park and Recreation Improvements
- Chapter 5: Planning Considerations
- Appendices: outline of the planning process and Public input survey results

The Plan also has appendices which contain a detailed outline of the planning process, history of the parks, descriptions of previous county park plans and other plans that incorporate county parks, and results from the 2019 public input survey.
